OP Mainnet Symbol

Reintroducing the first chain on the Superchain—OP Mainnet. Its swirling binary arms cradle the birth of a star—a moment suspended in time in the form of O and P. As the home of OP governance, OP Mainnet has a prominent role representing Optimism and the partnerships we nurture. Like our core identity, we have some basic rules around its use, too.

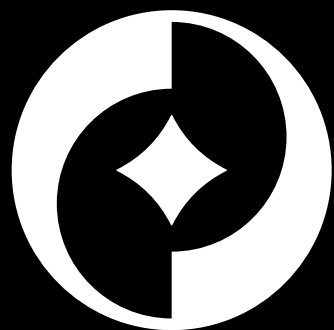
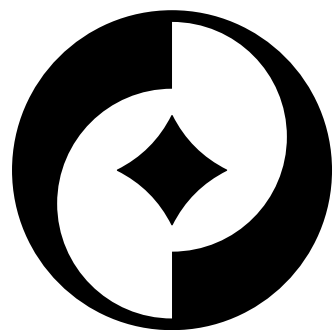

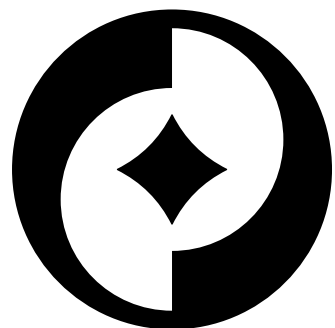
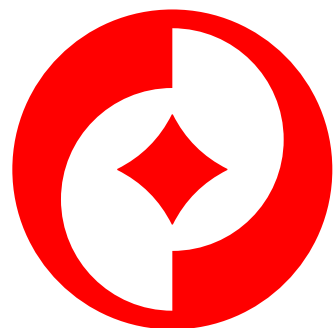
OP Mainnet Versions

Our main OP Mainnet symbol is...well...red. Sometimes black or white for limited color spaces or one-color Superchain trains. 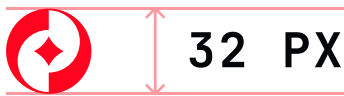


SMALL SIZE



Our symbol often finds itself in various orbits—some out of our control. To maintain graphic integrity and legibility, we’ve created two sizes and minimum size specs. Please follow the guidance shown below, even when flipping an asset over to a third party. Otherwise, our star might become a nebula.

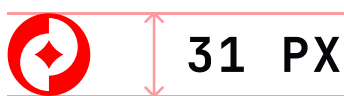
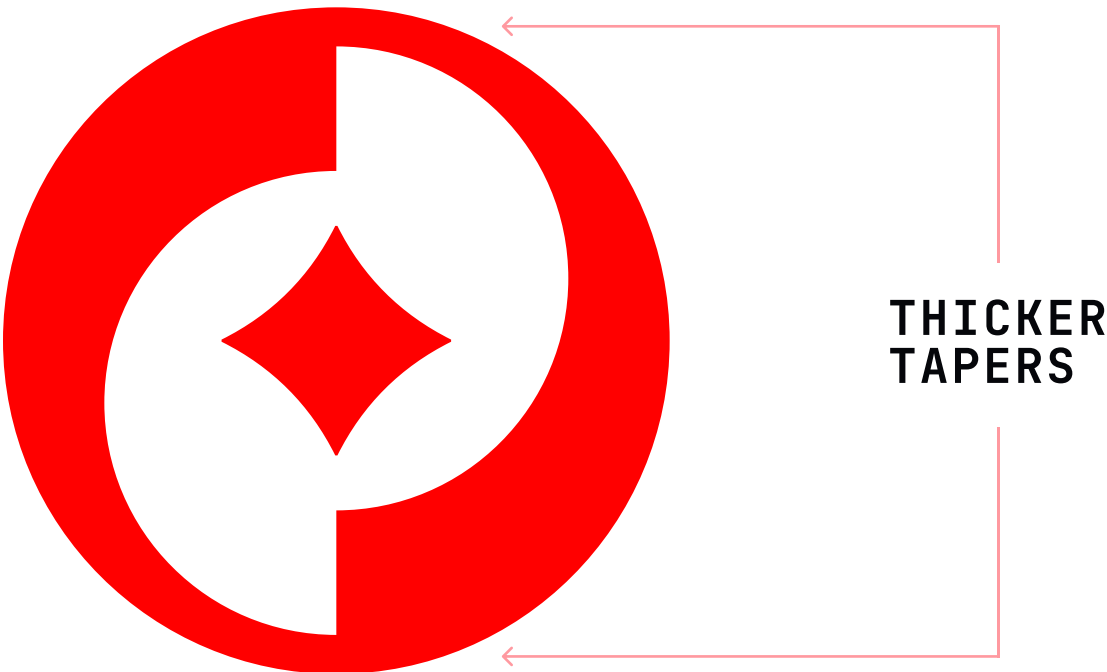


The regular size symbol is our macro-mezzo marvel. It can go from planetary all the way down to 32px high ‘n’ wide.

We’ve organized our files and folders to guide selection, but in case there’s any confusion, look for a file name like this one:

The small size symbol goes where only a micro can go—below 32px high ‘n’ wide on down to 12px (though we wouldn’t recommend using that size often).

The difference between small size file names and regular is the “-Sml”:

Misuse: Symbol

All our entity identity assets take time to create. Like a star. So please treat the OP Mainnet symbol versions like you would the rest of our assets—as if they were your children. Avoid the misuses mentioned directly or hinted at on this page, for any color version of the OP Mainnet symbol asset. Or size version, for you sneaky fellows.



DON'T COLLAPSE, WARP OR LET OUR SYMBOL FALL INTO A BLACK HOLE. IT'S A BEACON IN THE SUPERCHAIN SKY.



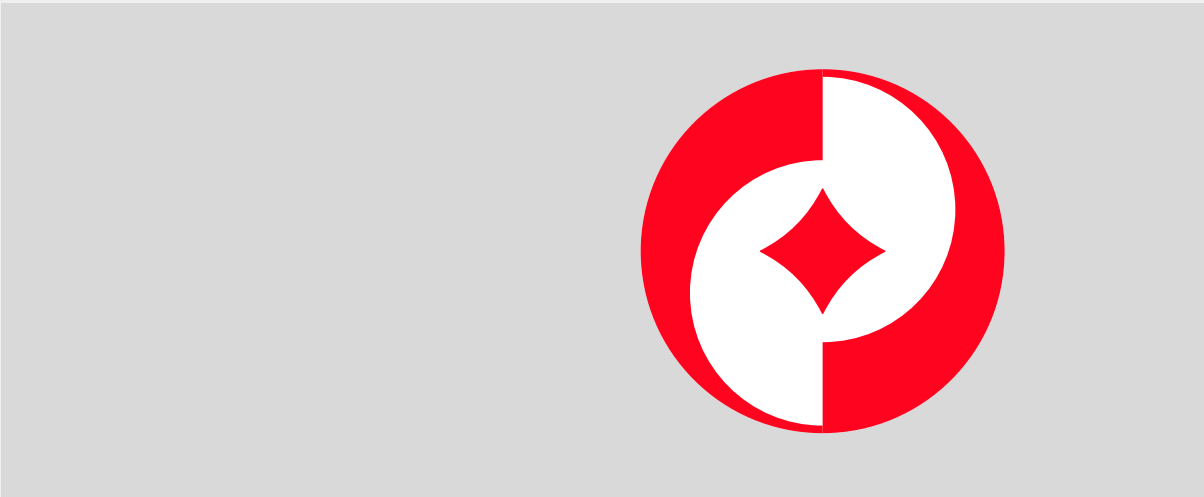
DON'T OUTLINE THE SYMBOL. THAT'LL MAKE THE TAPERING TOP 'N' BOTTOM HEAVY. WE'RE NOT SYMBOL SHAMING, THO.



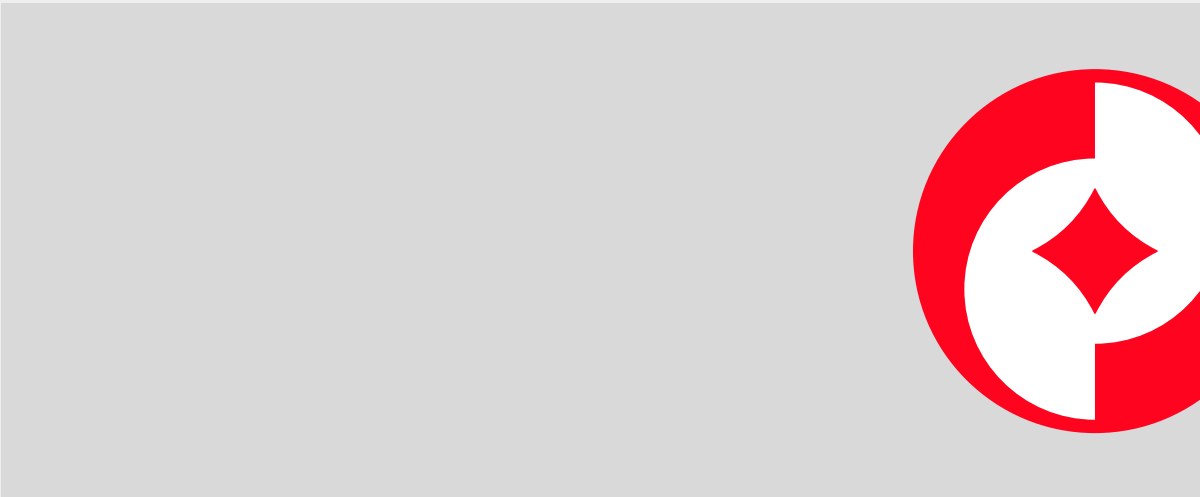
DON'T ADD EFFECTS LIKE DROP SHADOWS, 3D EXTRUSIONS OR EMBELLISHMENTS TO THE SYMBOL. IT'S DYNAMIC ENOUGH.



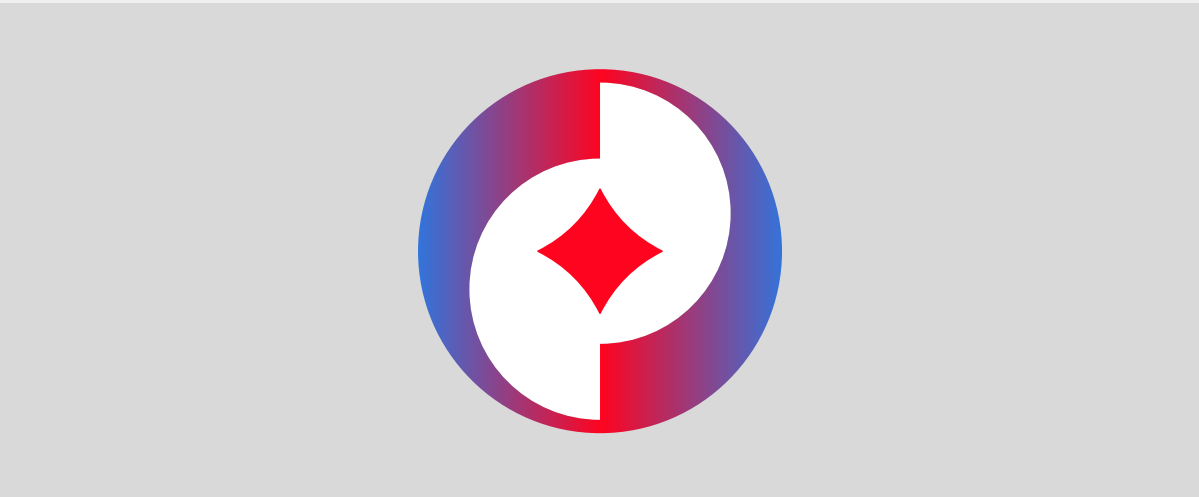
DON'T ROTATE THE SYMBOL AT ALL. NOT EVEN 90°. OKAY, MAYBE IN A MOGRAPH, BUT NOWHERE ELSE.



DON'T PAIR OR LOCK UP THE OP MAINNET SYMBOL WITH OUR CORE OPTIMISM SYMBOL. THINGS MAY START TO GET WEIRD.



DON'T CROP THE SYMBOL OFF ANY EDGE OF THE LAYOUT. WE WANT THIS STAR CHAIN TO STAY IN THE SYSTEM.



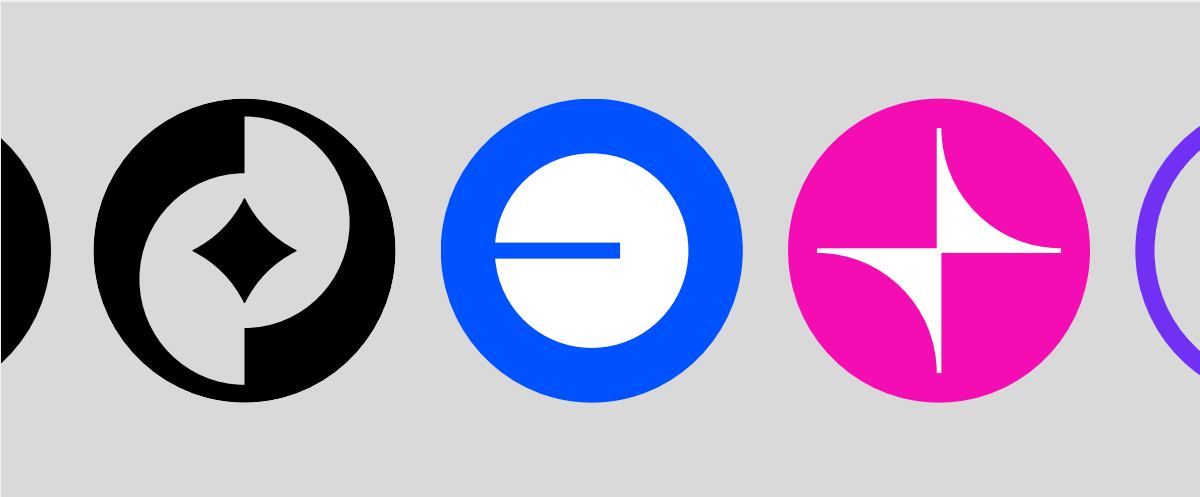
DON'T RECOLOR THE ANY PART OF THE SYMBOL. IT MAY SPARKLE, BUT IT'S NOT A DISCO BALL.



DON'T LET THE SYMBOL DISAPPEAR INTO A CLUSTER OF CLUTTERED OR LOW-CONTRAST BACKGROUND CONTENT.



DON'T REMOVE OR REDRAW ANY PART OF THE SYMBOL. IT'LL END UP LOOKING LIKE A DONUT OR A FRISBEE.



DON'T USE THE WRONG COLOR OR SIZE VERSION IN THE SUPERCHAIN LOGO TRAIN. THAT'S NOT THE PLACE TO STAND OUT.




DON'T MASK IMAGES OR GRAPHICS INTO THE SYMBOL. THE SPARKLING STAR JUST ATE, AND IT'S QUITE FULL.



DON'T PAIR OR LOCK UP THE OP MAINNET SYMBOL WITH THE OPTIMISM WORDMARK. NO FRANKENBRANDING ON OUR WATCH!


In crypto storage wallets, our OP Mainnet symbol goes solo, like the star it is—or as a circle or square icon locked up with a larger token icon (represented by the OP symbol). Use the small size icon version for these lockups so the OP Mainnet symbol reads better. Note: The network icon is a switch hitter. Depending on the platform, it'll be at the left or right of the token icon.



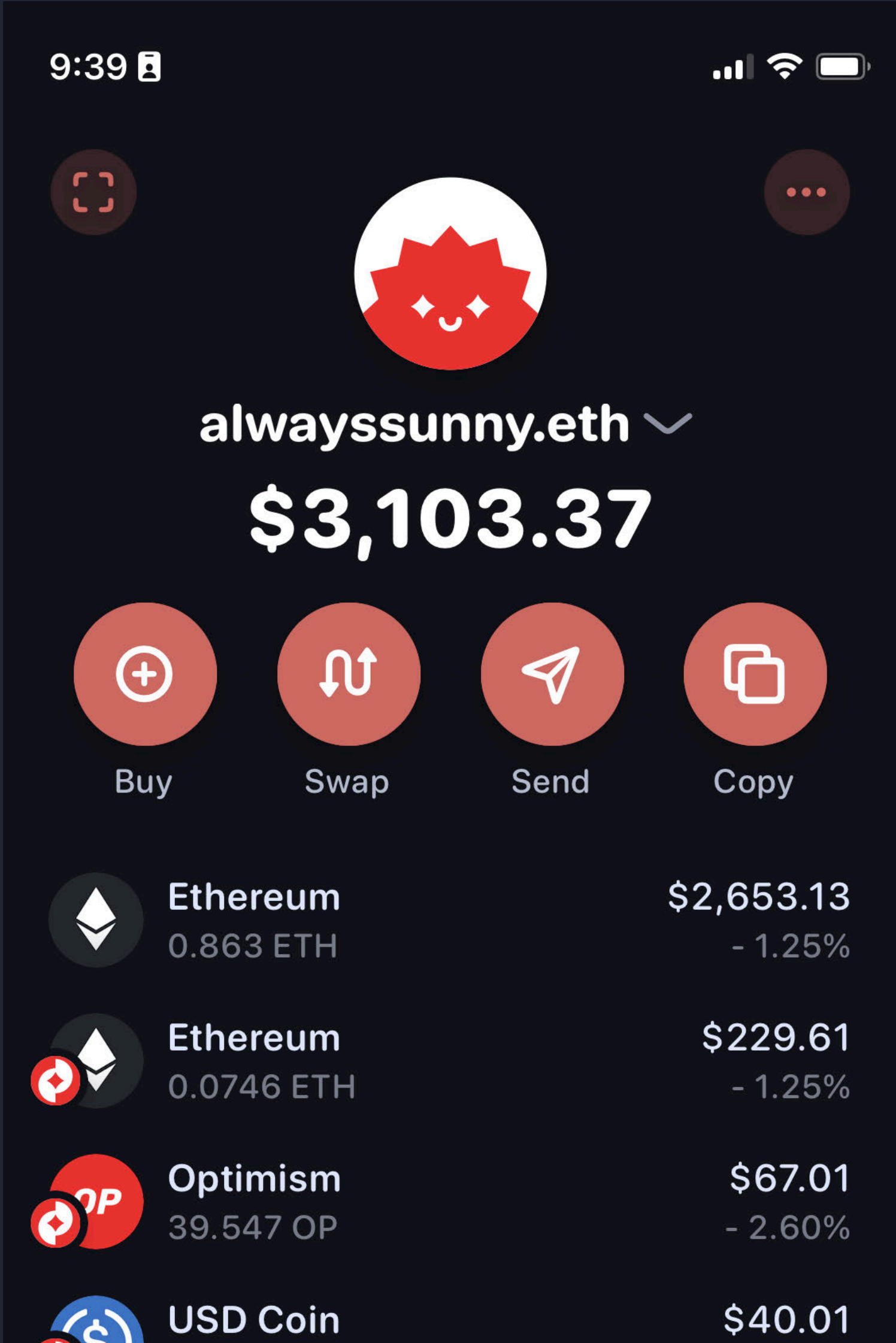

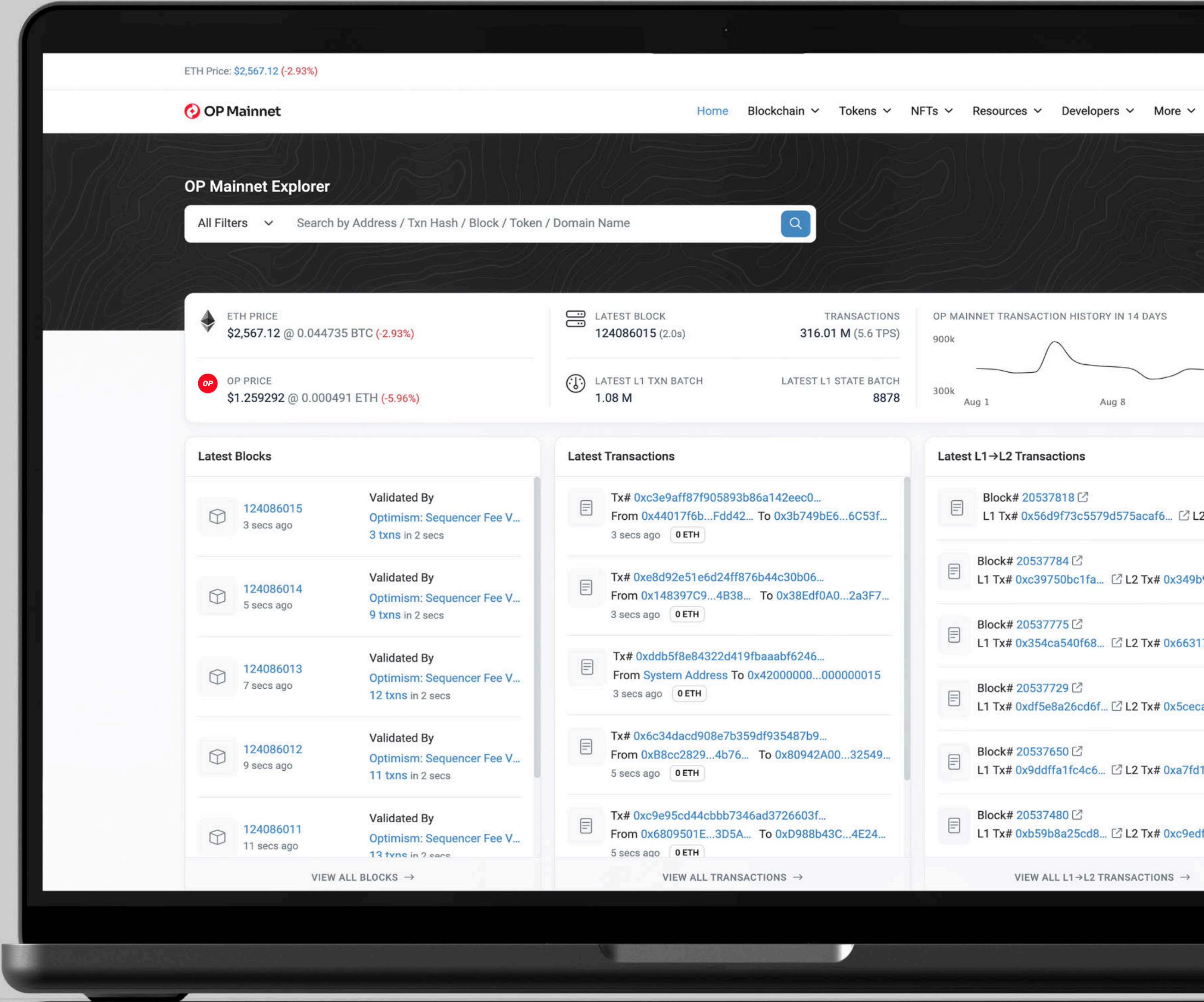

OP Mainnet Examples



Here are more examples of things we just can't control—other people's platforms. In these instances, use our (small size) symbol where appropriate, even if there's text that will appear alongside it. Notice how the token is the OP Mainnet icon and not our core identity symbol? That's the way to handle those placements.



All aboard the sparkle train! To represent the Superchain’s momentum toward a collaborative superfuture, we’ve produced an ever-growing ecosystem of OP Chain symbols—including those of our partners and OP Mainnet. When this ecosystem is full of full-color symbols, ours goes red. For one-color applications, our symbol may be black or white.
